



Come home to Que Toi.

Meaning "my village" in Vietnamese, Que Toi Village is all about an authentic seaside stay, close to Nature with serendipitous touches of comfort & genuine Vietnamese hospitality.

"Que" evokes a strong sense of "home" in Vietnamese, a place filled with enduring memories of family and friends where your heart yearns to return no matter where you may be.

Comprised of 24 bungalows set directly on Xuan Dai Bay and backed by green, forested hills, Que Toi Resort offers rustic yet stylish accommodations just steps from the beach.

While the bungalows offer complete peace and privacy, the Pool Deck is the social heart of the resort with cabanas and sun loungers set around a palm-fringed infinity pool overlooking the bay. Enjoy an ice cold beer or refreshing cocktail served up by our bar staff or throw a freshly-caught lobster or two onto the barbeque in our self-catering area.

Located halfway between the coastal resort cities of Nha Trang and Danang on Vietnam's South-Central Coast, Que Toi Resort is minutes from the sleepy fishing town of Song Cau known for its 80 km of scenic coastline and about an hour's drive from Phu Cat Airport (Quy Nhon) with multiple daily flights from Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City.

Song Cau and its surrounds are home to quiet beaches, emerald rice fields and floating lobster farms, all blissfully untouched by mass tourism, making it an appealing alternative to up-and-coming Quy Nhon to the north or the more established beach destinations of Nha Trang and Danang.

If you've ever wondered what it would be like to be among the first to discover the next "It" destination, this is your chance.

SLEEP

Que Toi Resort has 24 guest rooms set directly on our private stretch of white sand beach. Each bungalow offers a generous 62 sqm of indoor and a total of 160 sqm living space highlighted by a wall of glass framing postcard-perfect views of the bay.

Interiors are minimalist-chic, enhanced by natural materials including wood, bamboo and stone in shades of turquoise and beige, borrowing from Mother Nature's own palette.

Each bungalow also enjoys its own covered outdoor terrace with upholstered lounger and bistro table and chairs, leading to a private, landscaped garden and direct beach access.

EXPLORE

Ringed by green hills, scenic Xuan Dai Bay is home to a vibrant fishing and lobster farming industry. Explore the tranguil waters of the bay dotted with fishing boats and floating seafood farms with the resort's own stand up paddle boards and kayaks.

The flat roads around Que Toi Village are also ideal for cycling. Hop on one of the resort's bicycles and cycle past lush rice paddies into the sleepy town of Song Cau.

Set aside a half- or full-day to spend on the resort's private island of Nhat Tu Son. Travel 20 minutes by boat right from the resort or transfer by car and walk over the exposed sandbar to the forested island. Spend the day lazing on the small beach and swim the clear, emerald waters or hike around the island with a stop at the bird sanctuary and koi pond.

A local highlight is visiting one of these lobster farms, ingeniously buoyed by floating barrels. Climb aboard the platform and see how the locals breed, raise, feed and harvest these colorful crustaceans in netted pens suspended in the waters below. You can even buy a few to enjoy back at the resort, excellent grilled with a touch of butter and garlic.

Enjoy a few peaceful hours on the water as the sun rises, lulled by the gentle rocking of the boat and the sound of the waves. Try your hand at fishing the local way or simply observe as the fishermen expertly cast their nets.

Nature lovers can spend a blissful day beach hopping while history buffs will enjoy visiting the dozen or so Hindu-influenced Cham towers dating back as early as the 10th century, grand vestiges of the seafaring Champa Kingdom which once ruled over this area of Vietnam.

A one-hour drive south towards Tuy An, the capital of Phu Yen Province, makes for a great half-day trip, with stops at the unusual, honeycomb-like rock formations at Ghenh Da Dia; the 1892 Gothic-style Mang Lang Catholic Church; and the Quang Duc Xua Cultural Center showcasing historical artifacts and traditional pottery of the region in a beautiful wooden house set amidst lush gardens.
